



Announcing API Exhibitions

API Exhibitions are immersive online shows of works by API artists created by well-known curators.

Using advanced technologies, API online exhibitions are presented in variations of groups of single images, diptychs and triptychs, intermixed with text and short curatorial essays.

How work is chosen

When creating API exhibitions, curators produce calls for submissions, which are sent to the API community of artists. Artist may use image submission credits to upload new work (not just work found on API) directly to the curator's exhibition folder for consideration. Image submission credits are available for a nominal fee.

Curators may also use their private API collection's module to choose work from the 21,000+ images already published on Art Photo Index.

Frequency of shows

New shows will be announced several months in advance of their openings.
